



To avail book bank facilities, a student has to apply to the Principal, giving details of family income etc, immediatly after the issuance of Notice in this regard. All books have to be returned within 3 days from the last day of University examination.

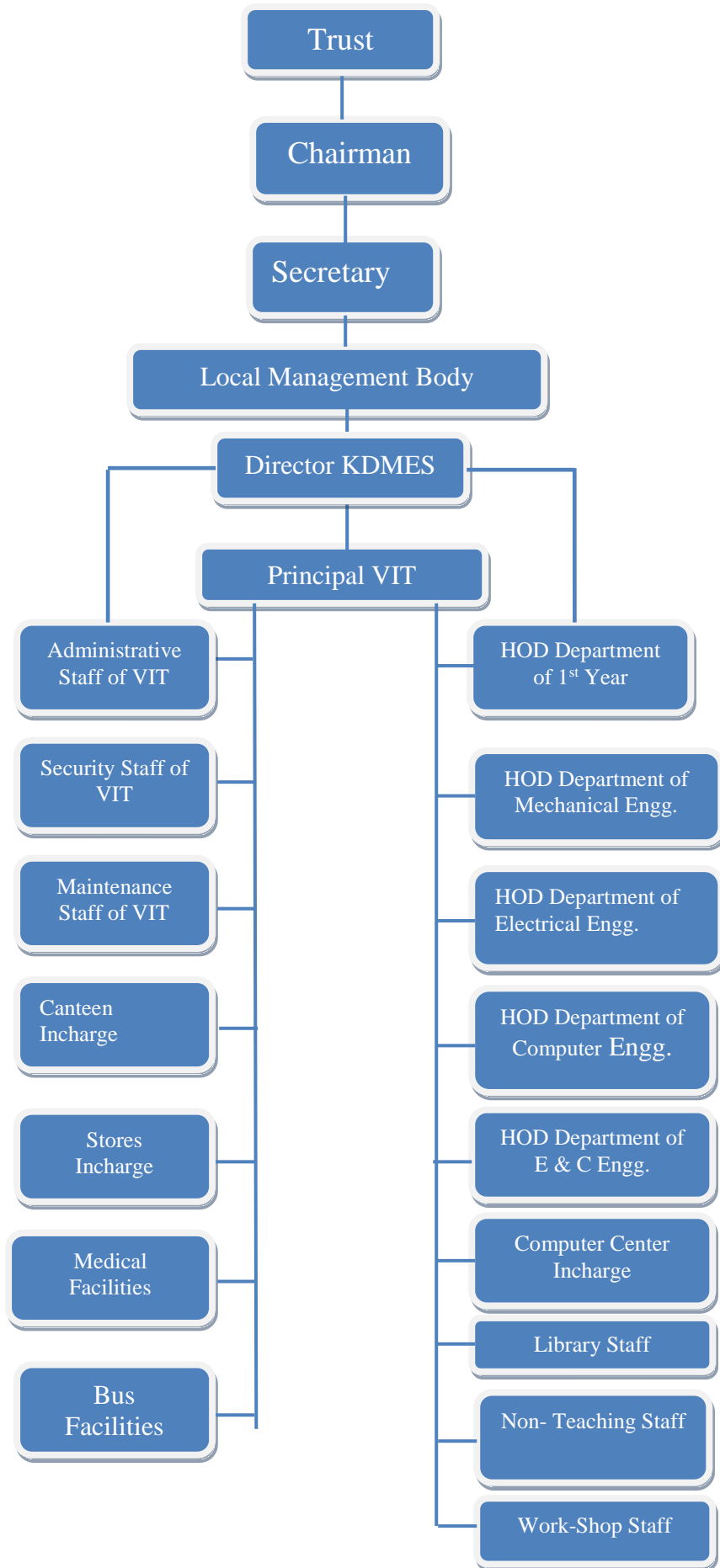
